



 <p>Achieve seamless and effective integration of all cancer services</p>	Leverage digital solutions to support coordination of care, access to comprehensive health information and system navigation for patients, their care partners and providers.	<p>Develop a provincial radiation treatment repository to improve province-wide quality of radiation treatment plans and support continuity of care.</p> <p>Implement standardized nomenclature to support creating and monitoring provincial standards in radiation plan quality (i.e. all hospitals speaking the same language when referring to treatment plans).</p> <p>Develop local plans of action to ensure continuity of care during emergency situations (ex. Cyberattacks, floods, infrastructure breakdowns).</p> <p>Explore mechanisms to inform Regional Cancer Programs of patients' previous radiation treatment history.</p>
