Know the facts

Get checked with a test to help prevent cervical cancer.

Anyone with a cervix who is or has ever been sexually active can get cervical cancer. A cervical screening test checks for the signs of cancer before it starts.

HPV causes cervical cancer.

Human papillomavirus (HPV) is common and usually goes away on its own. If HPV does not go away for many years, it can lead to cervical cancer.

Regular screening is important for preventing cervical cancer. Talk to your doctor, nurse practitioner or midwife if you are overdue for your cervical screening test.
