Palliative Clinical Specialist Radiation Therapist - Cancer Centre of Southeastern Ontario

This position will be responsible for taking on a leadership role within the palliative care team. The position will be focused on assessing patients for eligibility for treatment, obtaining informed consent, defining the dose to be delivered, providing technical and treatment planning consultation, and assessing patients during treatment. It is anticipated that this position will reduce the wait time for palliative patients receiving radiation therapy, increase access for patients, further develop an interprofessional team approach to patient care, and improve the patient experience and satisfaction.

Head and Neck Planning Image Definition and Contouring Clinical Specialist Radiation Therapist – London Regional Cancer Program

This position will provide focused expertise for the tasks of image fusion, image review and target delineation and as a result produce time savings for radiation oncologists in the Head and Neck site group and reduce wait times between performing necessary scans and plan creation. It is anticipated that by improving access to the planning process, patients will be able to start treatment earlier.

Skin Cancer Clinical Specialist Radiation Therapist – London Regional Cancer Program

This position will support the Skin Cancer disease site group by providing a number of services across the continuum of care. Activities to be performed by the CSRT may include: referral triaging, conducting new and follow-up patient assessment and history-taking, reviewing and communicating pathological results, performing clinical mark-ups for patients to receive radiation therapy, and delineating treatment areas for photodynamic therapy (PDT). The Skin Cancer CSRT will also serve as the primary resource for patients during and after their treatment.

Brachytherapy Clinical Specialist Radiation Therapist – Odette Cancer Centre

By expanding the radiation therapist's scope of practice to include some procedures previously done by radiation oncologists, this position is designed to provide a more streamlined patient flow, increase efficiency and utilization of the Brachytherapy Program's space and resources, and reduce wait times for patients.

Stereotactic Body Radiation Therapy (SBRT) Clinical Specialist Radiation Therapist – Odette Cancer Centre

This position is designed to work within the SBRT Program and perform tasks such as, but not limited to, the following: ensuring efficient use of resources and proficient identification of patients who would benefit from SBRT; triaging referrals for suitability for SBRT; explaining protocols to patients; obtaining informed consent; following patients throughout the treatment journey; contouring normal structures, organs at risk, and the target in certain cases; performing multi-modality image registration; assessing treatment plans; and performing the first treatment day image approval in place of a physician. It is anticipated that this position will facilitate more timely access to treatment and the ability to offer SBRT treatments to more patients.
