



## Cancer screening is about helping you live a good life

Three organized cancer screening programs are offered to eligible people in Ontario.

**BREAST:** Mammogram

**CERVICAL:** Pap Test

**COLON:** Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT)



# The screening tests are free for eligible people in Ontario.

## **BREAST**

Mammogram

People 50 to 74 years old who are eligible

Every 2 years for most

## **CERVICAL**

Pap Test

People 21 to 70 years old who are eligible

Every 3 years for most

## **COLON**

Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT)

People 50 to 74 years old who are eligible

Every 2 years for most

If you think you may be at high risk for breast cancer or colorectal cancer, talk to your primary care provider to see if you are eligible to get screened earlier.
