Getting checked for lung cancer can help protect your health

Getting checked is recommended for people who are at high risk of getting lung cancer. Talk to your family doctor or nurse practitioner, or contact an Ontario Lung Screening Program (OLSP) location to find out if you qualify.



You may qualify to get checked for lung cancer if you are:

- **Mate 35** Age 55 to 80
- Have smoked cigarettes every day for at least 20 years (doesn't have to be 20 years in a row).
